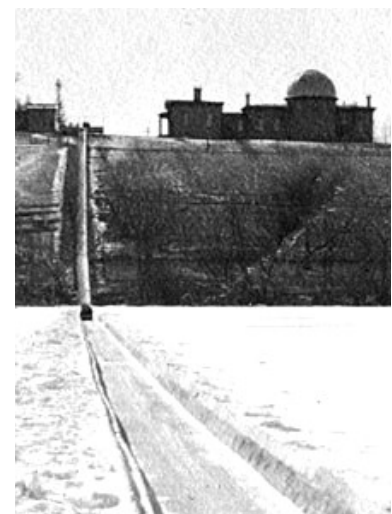

Following a year's study with the late Leen 't Hart at the Netherlands Carillon School in Amersfoort, Anderson earned a diploma in carillon in June 1980. Returning to Madison, he was appointed University Carillonneur in August 1986.
