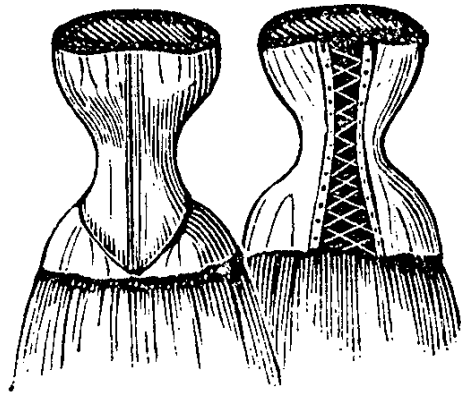


Victorians' Secrets: The Revealing History of Women's Underwear

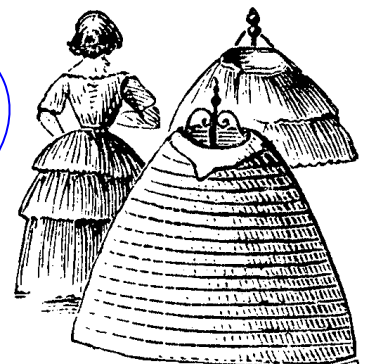
