This new book is the second volume of Dick Wagner's work on gay history in Wisconsin. Our state has been a national leader in LGBTQ rights with pioneering legislative statutes. In fact, Wisconsin became the first state in the nation to enact a gay rights bill in 1969 that banned discrimination in employment, housing and public accommodations based on sexual orientation. Later, the state Legislature legalized all sexual relations between consenting adults, including same-sex. To this day, Wisconsin is the only state to elect three out members of Congress: Steve Gunderson, Tammy Baldwin, and Mark Pocas. These state-wide accomplishments were made possible by local LGBTQ legislators, elected officials, activists, business people, everyday citizens & their allies.
